1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including Appendix B.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions are available at the Toronto Windsurfing Club (TWC) or on-line at www.torontowindsurfingclub.com.

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 The online official notice board is located at www.torontowindsurfingclub.com.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **4.1** The event is open to all boards, including: windsurf, windfoil and wingfoil.
- **4.2** Boards may enter the event by registering online at www.torontowindsurfingclub.com.
- **4.3** Each competitor under 18 years of age must submit a completed PARENT/GUARDIAN DECLARATION prior to racing. The declaration can be found at www.torontowindssurfiingclub.com..
- **4.4** To be considered an entry in the event, aboard shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees, when applicable.
- **4.5** Registration may be limited dependent upon the restrictions placed upon the series by the COVID-19 pandemic.

5 FEES

5.1 There are no entry fees for Saturday Outer Harbour Series. The entry fees for the Sunday Mammoth are online with the Registration Form.

7 VENUE

7.1 Launching area is located south of the TWC clubhouse. Sailing will be in the Outer Harbour South ogf the TWC.

8 COURSES

- **8.1** Courses to be sailed will be the TWC Saturday Afternoon windward-leeward courses.
- **8.2** Courses to be announced at the Competitors's Meeting for the Round the Island Mammoth, Outer Harbour Short Course and Learn to Windsurf course.

9 SCORING FOR THE SATURDAY OUTER HARBOUR REGATTA'S

- **9.1** The Saturday Outer Harbour Regatta series consists of four or more Races.
- **9.2** Competitors may choose to be scored for completing one lap or two laps during a race.

10 DATA PROTECTION

10.1 By participating in the event, competitors grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, or other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

11 RISK STATEMENT

11.1 RRS 3 states:

'The responsibility for a competitor's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.'

By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, board handling errors, poor seamanship by other boards, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury.

12 INSURANCE

12.1 Each participating competitor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a board has third-party liability insurance.

13 PRIZES FOR ALL REGATTAS

- **13.1** Prizes may be given to boards placing first, second and third in each category.
- **13.2** Other prizes may also be awarded.

14 CONCUSSION AWARENESS
